Door Q Entertainment is a production company bringing genre entertainment (SciFi/Fantasy/Horror) to a multitude of groups across both old and new media platforms, including Video OnDemand and IP Television (IPTV). It's initial charter is to address the dearth in quality genre content to the gay demographics.

“This is one of those opportunities to really make two good things great,” Jody Wheeler, creator of doorQ.com said. “By blending experiences, histories, technologies and common interests, doorQ.com and OUTer can now increase the reach and exposure of gay-themed, genre entertainment in a way that will have the maximum impact for the majority of its fans.”

“Honestly, when The OUTer Film Festival was conceived, I felt alone in the Universe,” Timothy Caswell, founder and director of OUTer said. “I was proud to bring unique but overlooked genre film and video from around the world to
